Most recently, the Sugar Global Developer Conference was conducted, which in many ways is like an über-SDUG. Markku Suominen, our intrepid Finnish Sugar Hero, has also recently conducted a Sugar Day event in Helsinki, Finland. Other regional events are planned throughout 2007.
