Enter your name and code submission, accept the SugarCRM Contribution Agreement, and you're done!

As a side note, we're revamping this contribution page so you will be able to track your contribution with a tracking code, to watch its progress and to be notified when it is added into a release.

For more complex code submissions, please contact SugarCRM and we'll work with you to incorporate them into an upcoming release.
